The Department of Cardiac Surgery will discuss Morbidity and Mortality within our patient population monthly.

Cases presented will include, but not be limited, to those undergoing cardiac surgical procedures, implantation of cardiac assist devices such as LVAD and ECMO cannulation, and cardiogenic shock. Cardiac surgery procedures will include both open and percutaneous procedures.
