

Urology Grand Rounds (2026-2027)

This series is designed to enhance clinical practice through peer-to-peer learning and the review of complications encountered in urologic care. Participants will examine clinical cases and share experiences to improve competence and performance in patient management.

Through structured peer discussion, the series supports resident and student education while facilitating the identification, evaluation, and management of common causes of morbidity and mortality in urologic surgical patients.

The goal is to identify modifiable factors contributing to adverse outcomes and implement practice improvements to reduce future complications and mortality. From an institutional perspective, complication and mortality rates will be reviewed and compared over time to assess quality improvement efforts. From an educational perspective, residents and students will be engaged through targeted questioning to assess understanding of core urologic and surgical principles and reinforce evidence-based practices that minimize medical errors and adverse events.
