

Pharmacy Credit Reporting

Thomas Jefferson University is required to report Pharmacists' and Pharmacy Technicians' earned continuing pharmacy education credits to CPE Monitor® within 60 days of completing the activity.

The pharmacists and pharmacy technicians must include in their CloudCME profile:

- NABP ePID #
- Date of Birth (MM/DD)

If you do not have this information in your profile, credits cannot be submitted to CPE Monitor®.

What is CPE Monitor®?

[CPE Monitor®](#) is a collaborative service from The National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) and Accreditation Council of Pharmacy Education (ACPE) that provides an electronic system for pharmacists and pharmacy technicians to track their completed CPE credits. It also streamlines reporting and compliance verification for participating boards of pharmacy.

Why do I need a NABP ePID number?

Your NABP e-Profile ID is a permanent identification number that you need in order to receive credit for any ACPE-accredited continuing pharmacy education (CPE) activities.
